The Crisis Pregnancy Agency (the Agency) is a planning and co-ordinating body established to formulate and implement a strategy to address the issue of crisis pregnancy in Ireland.

We are committed to continually improving how environmentally-friendly we are. To help us achieve this we will follow the guidelines laid out in Sustainable Energy Ireland's (SEI) Energy Management Action Plan (MAP).

Through the implementation of our plan we will work to:

- Ensure that we comply with all relevant environmental legislation
- Set objectives and targets to help us become more environmentally-friendly
- Reduce the amount of energy, paper, plastic and other items we use
- Increase the amount we reuse and recycle
- Consider the environment when selecting goods and services, including when tendering, while at the same time, as a publicly-funded organisation, giving due regard to value for money
- Increase awareness among staff and other colleagues of our environmental practices and enable the public to access our policy
- Monitor and evaluate the implementation of our policy

The Agency has an Environment Committee who will take the lead in developing and implementing the policy. The Committee consists of a Senior Manager and other members of staff and meets regularly.

The Director of the Agency has ultimate responsibility for our environmental policy and performance.
